President's Message - Bruce Fitzpatrick

Dear Families and Friends,

The men have enjoyed many opportunities to participate in community activities recently. Arthur had the honor of riding with the Momence Fire Chief in the Momence Gladiolus Festival parade while several others rode or walked with the Manor's float. Many of the men entertained the crowd at the Fall Festival by singing and signing a variety of songs which followed a Road Trip theme. 38 of our men and 14 community members participated in the one mile fun run/walk at the Manor on the Sunday after the Festival. Approximately 50 men regularly work or volunteer in a variety of positions in the community including mowing lawns, providing janitorial services, working at K-Mart and Kroger, and volunteering at the Manteno Veteran's Home. These activities are valued by the men and provide an important message to the community, that persons with intellectual and developmental disabilities can and do contribute to society.



We have mourned the loss of Roy Turnbull and David Yenshaw; they each will be forever remembered with plaques in the chapel. We have also welcomed the families of new residents Brad Myers, Andy Robertson, and Doug Gagnon, we are glad you have joined the Good Shepherd family.

Building maintenance continues to be an active and on-going process. This summer we replaced the patios at five of the group homes, put a new roof on two group homes, re-paved Brother Alphonsus Drive, and completed landscaping projects at many of the homes. Renovations at the Maple Street group home remain in process as well as the renovation of one bathroom at Zurek group home. The roof of Camillus House is being replaced this fall and several heating and air conditioning projects are planned. We also plan to paint the interiors of three group homes this winter. In total, we maintain fourteen group homes, the Brothers House, and Camillus House including Jerry's Lounge, the gymnasium, the Reutter Day Program addition, and the McAllister Infirmary addition. We also have 55 acres, including the cemetery, to maintain. Our Maintenance Department and Building and Grounds Committee deserve great thanks for their ongoing efforts to keep the Manor in shape.



The Illinois State budget for fiscal year 2014 once again does not include any increase in the per-person reimbursement rate the Manor receives. Thus, once again, we will need to manage increasing expenses for utilities, food, staff, insurance, and building maintenance without new State revenues. This shortfall continues to place an increasing importance on fundraising and support from our benefactors.

I would like to take this opportunity to encourage every reader to review the list of donors and supporters of the Manor and when you recognize a name, call that person to say thank you. The support from our benefactors allows Good Shepherd Manor to fulfill its mission. Thank you all!

Infirmery/Nursing Services

FLU AND COLD SEASON IS UPON US!

The flu and the common cold have similar symptoms. It can be difficult to tell the difference between them. In general, the flu is worse than the common cold. Symptoms such as fever, body aches, tiredness, and cough are more common and intense with the flu. People with colds are more likely to have a runny or stuffy nose.

Flu symptoms include:

- A 100°F or higher fever (not everyone with the flu has a fever)
- A cough and/or sore throat
- Headaches and/or body aches
- Chills
- Fatigue
- Nausea, vomiting, and/or diarrhea (most common in children)



Seek medical attention immediately if you experience any of the following:

- Difficulty breathing or shortness of breath
- Purple or blue discoloration of the lips
- Pain or pressure in the chest or abdomen
- Sudden dizziness
- Confusion
- Severe or persistent vomiting
- Seizures

You can treat [flu symptoms](#) without medication by:

- Getting plenty of rest
- Drinking clear fluids like water, broth, sports drinks, or electrolyte beverages to prevent becoming dehydrated
- Placing a cool, damp washcloth on your forehead, arms, and legs to reduce discomfort associated with a fever
- Putting a humidifier in your room to make breathing easier
- Gargling salt water (1:1 ratio warm water to salt) to soothe a sore throat
- Covering up with a warm blanket to decrease chills.

[Vaccination](#) is the best way to protect yourself from the flu. Everyone 6 months of age and older should get vaccinated against the flu. Take everyday precautions, like washing your hands, to protect your health.

Manor Matters

Our Condolences to the family and friends of Brother Mark Harmueller.

Brother Mark Harmueller, BGS was born on Easter Sunday, April 1, 1934. Given the name Paul by his parents, he was born to the late Clara (Hammernik) and the late Frank Harmueller in Milwaukee, Wisconsin. Paul was one of two children. Clara and Frank also had a daughter, Clara, now deceased.



Paul entered the Little Brothers of the Good Shepherd congregation on September 29, 1960. He received his religious habit on January 19, 1961 and was given the name Mark. Brother Mark professed First Vows on March 26, 1962 and made Perpetual Vows on March 24, 1969. Mark served the needs of the homeless, the disabled, and his religious community in a variety of capacities. He served the homeless poor in New Orleans, Louisiana; Philadelphia, Pennsylvania; Miami, Florida, and Toronto, Ontario, Canada.

Mark also ministered to the individuals with developmental disabilities in Columbus, Ohio; Albuquerque, New Mexico; Bernalillo, New Mexico; Kansas City, Missouri; New Lexington, Ohio; and Momence, Illinois. In 1970 Brother Mark spearheaded the community effort to begin a Vocation Centre in Waterford, Ireland. He was also on staff at the Cardinal Manning House of Prayer in Los Angeles, California.

Too numerous to mention are the many administrative positions Brother Mark held in the Little Brothers community. He served a dual role as Director of Ministry and Superior of the local community in many of his assignments.

In 2010, Brother Mark was the first member of the Little Brothers of the Good Shepherd community to celebrate his 50th anniversary in religious life.

Brother Mark passed away on June 12, 2013. Funeral services were held at St. Patrick Catholic Church in Momence, IL. with Inurnment at Memorial Crypt Chapel in Albuquerque, New Mexico.
