President's Message - Bruce Fitzpatrick

Dear Families and Friends,

This past Christmas season we were abundantly blessed with kindness from many of our families and supporters. On Christmas Eve the men received Christmas gifts from the Wagoner family and United Commercial Travelers of America; Christmas Day dinner was donated by a local restaurant, and several area organizations provided festive programs for the men throughout the season. The staff and I are also very appreciative of the Christmas gift received from the families.

We are beginning a year long celebration to welcome in our 40th Anniversary which happens on March 1st, 2011. At our various events and fund raisers we will make special references and hopefully share stories from the past. On March 1, 1971, we opened our doors, since that time:

- 249 men have lived at the Manor – two men came twice
- 94 of them were admitted in the first year
- 36 of the 94 men are still at the Manor
- At the time of admission, the average age of these 36 men was 25, now they are 64
- The youngest of that group then was 19, the oldest of this group now is 79

On March 1, 1971 we admitted five men, two of them are still with us – Jerry Taibl (on the right) and Jim Jaster. It has been our privilege to know these 247 men and their families.

I would like to welcome the following men and their families to Good Shepherd: Harold Harla, Andy Devors, Weston Tobek, and Mark Chesser. We hope you find Good Shepherd Manor to be a long-term home. With sadness we say good bye to our friend Howard Liberman. Howard passed away on February 21 and will be memorialized with a plaque in the main Chapel.



On Valentines Day, 117 of us gathered at the Drury Lane Theater to feast and enjoy the musical *Funny Girl*. The food was bountiful, the performance was outstanding, and the company was exceptional. I thank you all for attending and sharing the afternoon with Good Shepherd Manor.

In February we were surveyed by CARF (Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities) for our national accreditation, and by the Department of Human Services for our Day Program license. In both cases the surveyors were very complimentary of the staff and services provided by the Manor. One surveyor wrote: "The wide variety of activities allows the client something to do everyday ... the staff showed a genuine concern for the clients ... Good Shepherd Manor is a great agency that provides a great service." We will not receive the outcome from CARF until later in March.

The financial crisis in Illinois continues to be headline news. We have tried to work closely with the State to receive payments in a timely manner (1-3 months behind) and to maintain our census. Illinois is implementing a pilot project that will move the Medicaid system to a Managed Care system – see related story (page 7). This project, called the "Integrated Care Program" is estimated to save the State around \$200,000,000. The Ligas class action lawsuit is still active and a new Consent Decree has been agreed to by the State. The new Decree requires individuals to actively request a desire to move to a "community setting." This revised Decree should not affect Good Shepherd in an adverse way.

Spring is nearly upon us and the new season will bring much activity. Good Shepherd remains an active place for the men and the staff. We look forward to providing services for the next 40 years. I hope to see many of you at either the Step Up to the Plate family meetings, the Brunch Auction, the Balmoral Golf Outing, or our new Lake Michigan Cruise event. Again, on behalf of the Brothers, staff, and men, thank you for your trust and support.



Satisfaction Survey Results

Annually each resident and guardian is asked to complete a satisfaction survey. The survey is broken down into three service areas: the Day Program services (DP), the Residential services (Res), and General services (Gen). The person is asked to rate their level of satisfaction on a scale of 1-3 for the residents and 1-5 for the guardians for 21 different questions. For example, "How satisfied are you with opportunities to work in the community?"



The charts above represent the averaged results of the client and guardian satisfaction surveys in 2009. The goal for client satisfaction is to score a 2.5 on the 3 point scale, 3 being perfectly satisfied. The goal for guardian satisfaction is to score a 4 on the 5 point scale, 5 being perfectly satisfied. As can be seen, both the clients and guardians report a high level of satisfaction with the services provided by the Manor. We are happy to report that in each of the 21 areas questioned we exceeded our goal. Clients reported the highest level of satisfaction (scored 2.92) with protection of their rights. Guardians reported the highest level of satisfaction (scored 4.85) with the safety and cleanliness of the homes. Thank you all for participating in these surveys.



NURSING SERVICES

Happy Spring! The infirmary remains a very busy place especially with the continuance of cold and flu season. While the H1N1 pandemic did not hit as hard as expected in this area, we are still monitoring the situation. We did finally receive the H1N1 vaccine from the Kankakee County Health Department and have gotten nearly all of the consents back from those guardians wishing to have their family member vaccinated. Nearly 100 families have chosen to have their resident vaccinated against H1N1 virus.



We continue to expand the services to the residents through the use of Biotech X-ray. Biotech, to date, has provided services to our residents in the comfort of familiar surroundings on 45 occasions over the past nine months at a savings of approximately 180 staff hours and at no cost to Good Shepherd Manor, nor the residents' families. The turnaround time from order to receiving the test results has generally been less than 12 hours. We are very pleased with Biotech's services and commitment to the men of Good Shepherd Manor.

I would also like to take this opportunity to re-introduce you to Catrina Haynes, RN, who recently returned as a part-time nurse to Good Shepherd Manor. Catrina worked here from 2007-2008 as a part-time LPN and returned to school to obtain her Associate's Degree from Kankakee Community College. Catrina continues to work full-time at the Illinois Veteran's Home in Manteno, Illinois. She resides in St. Anne, Illinois with her two daughters. WELCOME BACK, CATRINA!

IN THE NEWS: MEDICAID TO MANAGED CARE

The State of Illinois is implementing a change to the Medicaid system that may affect the benefits of some of our individuals at the Manor. The program is called the "Integrated Care Program" and seeks to move the current Medicaid system to a Managed Care system.

Initially, the program will affect individuals who are aged, blind, or disabled and rely on Medicaid as their sole source of funding. Individuals who are eligible for Medicare Part A or enrolled in Medicare Part B will not be affected. Affected individuals will be required to enroll in a Health Management Organization (HMO) as early as July 2010.

Phase I of this change will affect the medical benefits of the individual and is tentatively scheduled to begin in October 2010. Phases II and III will affect the residential and day program services and would be implemented about one year after Phase I. It is our concern that the managed care system may severely limit your choice of doctors, hospitals, and providers like Good Shepherd.

At this time there are very few details of the plan. Based on the available information, I anticipate this change will affect seven of the men currently living at Good Shepherd; these individuals and their guardians have already been notified. Professional organizations and several State legislators, including our own Representative Lisa Dugan, are intervening to support the rights of choice for all individuals with developmental disabilities. I would ask that you contact your State Legislators to inform them of this change in the Medicaid system, and also to ask them to help protect the freedom to choose doctors, hospitals, and providers for all individuals with developmental disabilities.



It seems there *IS* a card for every occasion! This tongue-in-cheek cartoon recently appeared in the Chronicle of Philanthropy. While this cartoon does make us smile, the loss of the long-held \$500,000 grant for the Day Program in 2006, is still contributing to budgetary woes at the Manor.
