

The new group home is finally under construction, see page 7 for pictures. Presently, the home has a crawl space, floor, tornado shelter, and a garage. I am told the walls should be going up in a few days. We are happy to have this opportunity to provide more accessible living arrangements for the men. They are all very excited to see the construction in process.

I am happy (and relieved) to report that the new State budget did not cut funding for facilities like Good Shepherd Manor. Unfortunately, again it did not increase the funding or provide any cost of business increase.

The men are continuing to work very hard both on campus and in the community. Over the past year about 50 men have been working or volunteering in the community and have tallied more than 6,800 hours. Meanwhile the men working on campus have enjoyed steady re-packaging work from the Merisant Company and Baker & Taylor. We are pleased and honored to have these opportunities for the men to demonstrate their skills while earning money and gaining self esteem.

The men have enjoyed many outings and activities this summer. Currently they are preparing for the Gladiolus Festival, the parades, the County Fairs, and the Bears Training Camp. They have enjoyed several professional baseball games and a cruise on Lake Michigan. They had a great time watching the horse races at the Balmoral Race Track and a few men got to ride in the official pace car. In Special Olympics the men are trying their hand at volleyball this year. We wish them luck!

We continue to be blessed by many friends and families who choose to support the Manor. This support comes in the way of volunteer time, in-kind and monetary donations, gifts, memorials and tributes, sponsorships, family donors, naming opportunities, and the Shepherds Endowment Society. Our events have been successful because of the sponsors and participants. Our Sprinkler and Generator drive was successful because of donations from our families. Our future will be secured through the Endowment Society. And because of benefactors like you, the men will continue receive high quality compassionate care. Thank you.




Satisfaction Survey Results

Clients and guardians expressed a high level of satisfaction with the services provided by Good Shepherd Manor.

All clients and guardians are requested to complete a satisfaction survey annually. The clients rate 21 different topics on a 3 point scale with 1 being low and 3 being a high level of satisfaction. The guardians rate the same 21 topics but on a 5 point scale. The charts below show the level of satisfaction compared to goal, that the clients and guardians have with the Day Program (DP) services, the Residential (Res) services, and the General (Gen) services of Good Shepherd Manor.



Satisfaction scores this year were slightly higher than last year. The overall client satisfaction score was 2.75 and the overall guardian satisfaction score was 4.58. Clients reported the highest level of satisfaction with protection of their rights, while guardians reported the highest level of satisfaction with nursing services provided. We appreciate everyone's participation in this survey.

As the summer sun beams upon us this season, please remember, nearly all of our residents take medications that make them more susceptible to sunburn. **Blood pressure medications, diuretics, antihistamines and certain psychotropic medications can all interact with the sun.**

Please make sure that if you take your family member outside, even on a partially cloudy day, that you apply sunscreen to all exposed skin... paying special attention to ears, back of neck, noses, and in many cases, thinning hair areas on the top of the head unless the person will be wearing a cap.

2011 Amicus Certus Award Recipients

GARY RYAN

The Ryan family has been active in supporting Good Shepherd Manor from its inception. Bob & Marilyn Ryan were among the families that helped to get the Manor started many years ago. Bob was on the Board of directors from 1970-1978. Their son Bobby was among the first residents at the Manor.

Gary Ryan was born in the South Shore area of Chicago in 1950, the second of five children born to Bob and Marilyn Ryan. When Gary was five, the family built a home in the western suburb of LaGrange and enrolled Gary in school at St. Cletus. At the same time, the Ryan's decided to place their oldest son, Bobby at The Joseph P. Kennedy School in nearby Palos Park.

Gary graduated from high school at St. Ignatius College Preparatory High School in 1968 and from what is today Benedictine University in Lisle, IL in 1972 with a degree in Business Economics and a minor in Computer Science.

For the next thirty five years, Gary worked in the computer and telecommunications industries in sales, marketing and executive positions with Unisys, Oracle & AT&T.
