President's Message - Bruce Fitzpatrick

Dear Families and Friends,

Good Shepherd Manor began out of the love of families for their sons with intellectual and developmental disabilities. These families wanted their sons to have the best life they could have. This included a life of faith in God, a life where they could realize their talents and abilities, a life where they were safe and to have their needs met with compassion and love.

Over the past 47 years the Manor's programs and services have evolved to meet the ever changing needs of the men. While our services have changed our Mission remains strong with our focus on: 1) the men we serve, 2) the staff who provide the care and 3) the families of the men we serve.

Organizations in Illinois like Good Shepherd Manor are faced with a staffing shortage; employers are finding it difficult to find and retain qualified staff. Thankfully, the State has made an effort to provide direct care staff with increases in the budget last year and this current year.

Despite this shortage, GSM has been able to maintain a strong core of staff members who are continuously DEDICATED to the Mission and the men, and they prove it with every shift they work. Our average length of service for our staff members is 7.6 years.

Even though we continually receive the high marks from State surveyors during unannounced survey inspections, we have always believed that our families are our "best sets of eyes" as to how we are caring for their loved ones. Throughout the year we survey our residents and their guardians regarding their level of satisfaction with our services. We also evaluate our own programs against goals we establish. These are some of the results:

- 29 men are volunteering or working in the community; this is 88% of goal
- The men spent an average of 4,068 hours each quarter in a community work setting
- The men and their guardians report a 90% level of satisfaction with community work opportunities for the men
- 88% of the men learned a new residential based skill in the last year
- The men report a 97% level of satisfaction with nursing services, guardians report a 91% level of satisfaction
- The men report a 94% level of satisfaction with their goals, wants and needs are being met; guardians report a 91% level of satisfaction
- The men report a 99% level of satisfaction that their rights are protected; guardians report a 94% level of satisfaction
- The men and their guardians report a high level of satisfaction with the overall services provided, scoring 95% and 91% respectively.

We could not provide the services we do without our staff members. What truly separates the Manor from other like facilities is the word DEDICATION.

I thank all of our dedicated staff members.

Tips for Fall Fitness

Fall is a great time for shaping up! It is a good time to start a fitness program that sets good habits for the upcoming holiday season.

Take advantage of the weather. These months are a good time to exercise outdoors. The temperature is cooler. Raking leaves is a great way to get your heart pumping and burn some of those calories off. Visit parks and go hiking or biking on trails. Get those skateboards and skates out. Give a try with kayaking or canoeing. When the snow falls, try cross country skiing, downhill skiing, or snowshoeing. Engage in activities that you perceive as fun...then it doesn't seem like exercise!



Don't be a couch potato, be an active TV watcher. Get up and move during those commercials (and I don't mean to the refrigerator!) You can also develop a workout to do while watching a program.

Go dancing! Your local colleges, YMCA, YWCA, community recreation centers, and gyms have all been known to offer classes from square dancing to ball room dancing and everything in between.

Work exercise into your daily life. Park your vehicle further away from the doors of an establishment, take the stairs instead of an elevator. If you are a frequent flyer, walk to the terminals and avoid the "people movers." But, of course, to do this, remember to get to the airport in time!

Enjoy a daily swim, walk, or exercise class in a nice heated pool. There are venues that even have therapy bikes and treadmills in the water for a low impact workout.

Discover what motivates you. Some people are motivated by weight loss, others by strengthening or toning. Or maybe, it's preparing for that "fun run," 5K or marathon.

Workout with a friend. Meeting someone for a workout or class also increases the probability that you will continue whatever program you have started. It gives you someone to talk with and help hold each other accountable.

It takes about a month for the body to adapt to lifestyle changes. Try to stick with goals you have set for a least a month, by then your behavior pattern has adapted and you are more likely to continue your program. Set small, attainable goals that you can achieve along the way. Sometimes the "big picture" is overwhelming and will actually frustrate and work against you.

Find an activity that may not only change your body, but changes your mood and your life!

Residential and Day Program

The men of Good Shepherd Manor are fortunate to have many opportunities to work. There are opportunities available to the men for both paid and volunteer work. While many men choose to pursue these opportunities, others choose not to do so. Currently, men are offered the option to participate in several work activities. These include: paid sub-contract work secured through a local company, Baker and Taylor, which is a repackaging job; cleaning crew, in which men go to some local businesses to clean; lawn crew, in which men mow grass and do some general grounds work both on the GSM campus and in the community; there are also volunteer activities that men can participate in at the nearby food pantry and at the Veteran's Home in Manteno.



The staff in the Vocational room within the Day Program encourages the men to become more involved in the work opportunities available to them. This encouragement has had a positive effect. Within the last few months, we have seen some of the men who do not usually choose to participate in work opportunities decide to go on work trips. In the 4th quarter of fiscal year 2018 (April, May & June), men participated in 4,596 hours of work or volunteer activity. This is an increase from the 3rd quarter (January, February & March) in which men participated in 3,538 hours of work or volunteer activities. Much of the increase is due to the mowing season, which is currently underway.

Staff continues to encourage men to participate in the opportunities available to them. In order to participate, men must be physically able to perform the work that needs to be done, they must be in good health, and able and willing to follow directions and maintain appropriate behavior on the job. Many men express that they are content to participate in offered on-campus activities and elect not to pursue work or volunteer opportunities. In keeping with policy, we do not go on work outings
